Faculty Positions

- Initiates new programs to allow for the development of the individual student's artistic

Residencies, Commissions and Research

The music was accepted with critical acclaim from several national press agencies including The Straits Times.
- Invited as guest artist for New Music Week at Monmouth College to present works including the commissioning of a score for a theatrical production of Shakespeare's, "The Tempest".
- Created two new electro-acoustic instruments for Joyce Koh's innovative work, "On the String", as part of a \$50k National Arts Council (Singapore) research grant.
- Invited to STEIM (Studio for Electro-Instrumental Music) for two residencies focusing on instrument development. Research led to the successful innovation of the Strombophone.

Technical Creativity

- Originated and created new music as an international performer, composer and music technologist
- Produced and performed on Islak Kopek's debut self-titled album which reached the top 25 in the Turkish Jazz albums of 2008.
- Developed and published a concept album of the commissioned composition, "Tropendrit", with texts from the book of the same name by the author Albert Hagenaars. The work is a 100-minute composition for an electro acoustic ensemble published by In de Knipscheer.

- Manages a team of 12-fulltime faculty, 45 adjuncts, a team of administrators and technical support to create a community of cooperation and artistic development for students and faculty alike in a specialized Arts Institution.
